Jessica Williams commenced her studies at Norland College in Bath on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018 studying for the BA (Hons) in Early Years Development and Learning and the Norland Diploma. This is a three year full time course which consists of theoretical and practical modules, covering the skills and knowledge needed for working with babies, young children and their families. In each academic year, there are two semesters of twelve weeks and a shorter four week summer term. During this time there are blocks of lectures and practical placements.

The Norland Diploma incorporates practical elements such as Food and Nutrition, Sewing Skills, Care and Wellbeing, Play and Learning and practical placements. The practical placements are in a range of childcare settings such as schools, nurseries, special needs settings and a hospital placement.

Each student is prepared for future employment throughout their studies and has been DBS checked to ensure their suitability for working with children.

In June 2019, Jessica will have completed the first year of the degree and diploma and, as such, will have completed the Level 4 stage.
